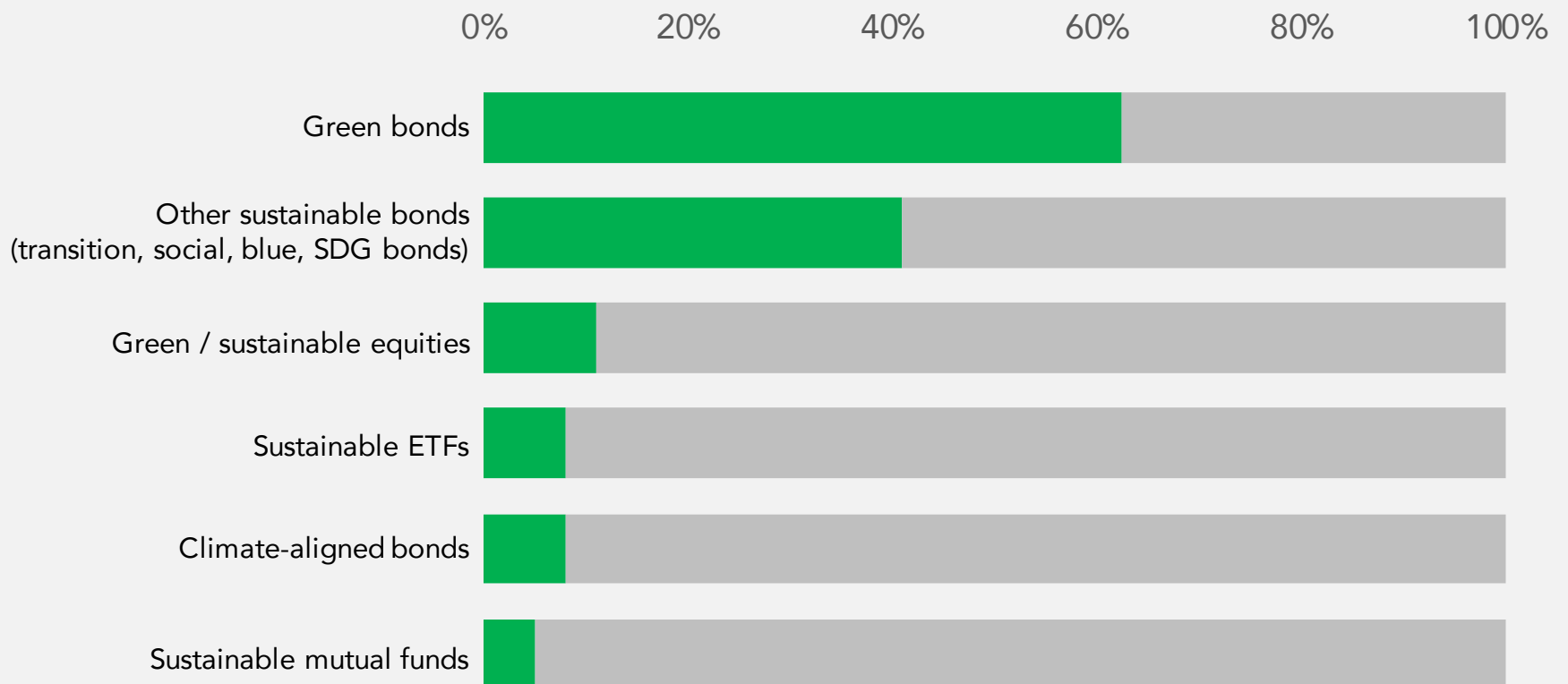


# Chart of the Day



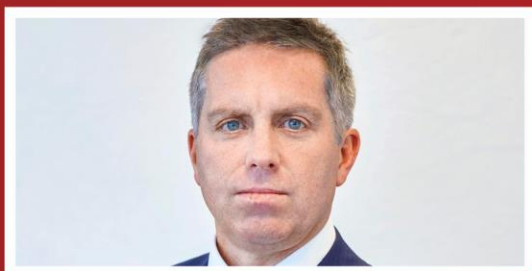
In a recent OMFIF survey of 73 global central banks, 2/3 said they plan to increase purchases of green bonds and 42% said they plan to buy other types of sustainable bonds. In addition, 58% of surveyed central bank reserve managers now include ESG factors in their investment approach, an increase from 43% in 2020.

Central Bank reserves managers' anticipated allocation to the following sustainable assets over the next 12 – 24 months, share of respondents



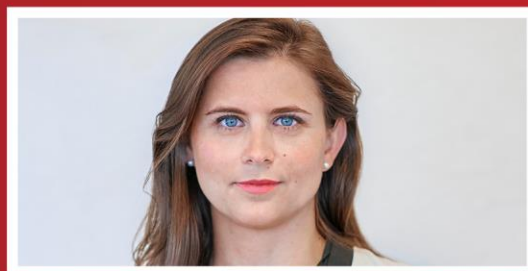
